ENERGY POLICY

As part of its environmental strategy, the Thompsons of Prudhoe Group of Companies (“the Group”) are committed to responsible energy management and will practise energy efficiency throughout all its premises, its use of vehicles, plant and equipment, wherever it is cost-effective to do so in order to achieve improvements to its energy performance.

This policy has the aim of minimising the energy usage to reduce the Group’s impact on the environment whilst maintaining the quality of its business activities. This shall be achieved by adherence to an Energy Management System which meets the requirements of ISO 50001. The system is documented and administered through the company’s Integrated Management System, which is certified by LRQA to ISO 50001.

Therefore it is the policy to monitor energy consumption in order to:

- avoid unnecessary expenditure
- protect the environment, and
- prolong the useful life of fossil fuels

The long- term objectives are to:

- buy fuels at the most economic cost;
- burn and use fossil fuels as efficiently as practicable;
- reduce where practical the amount of pollution, particularly CO₂ emissions, caused by its energy consumption;
- reduce, wherever practical, our dependence on fossil fuels through the use of ambient and renewable energy;
- continually improve its energy performance;
- support the purchase of energy-efficient products and services, and design for energy performance improvement;
- ensure that necessary resources and information are available to achieve the energy objectives and targets.

A framework for setting and reviewing energy objectives and targets shall be provided.

The Group are committed to complying with applicable legal requirements and other requirements to which the Group companies subscribe relating to their energy use, consumption and efficiency. To ensure the achievement of this policy the Group shall identify personnel within the Group Management with the necessary responsibility, authority and resources to implement the Policy.
